

MEET THE COACHING STAFF.....

Head Coach Al Corbeil

In his first season as the Head Baseball Coach, Coach Corbeil's Vikings won a school Record 43 games while claiming their first Suncoast Conference Championship. The Vikings earned their first berth in the FCSAA State tournament since 1992, going 3-2 and finishing 3rd. During one of the most historic seasons in school history, the baseball team set a school record with a 22 consecutive wins, reached rankings as high as 1st in the state and 4th in the country. They finished with a state best 43 wins, 12 losses and 1 Tie and ranked 11th in the country. Coach Corbeil saw 12 of his players earn First or Second Team All-Conference honors and 6 of the sophomores move onto 4 year colleges with scholarships.

Before becoming the skipper of the Vikings, Coach Corbeil spent the previous two years as the Recruiting Coordinator at Florida Southern College in Lakeland. In his two years at Florida Southern, the team finished with identical records of 41-16 and received two post-season berths to the South Regional Tournament. The Moccasins were #1 in the NCAA Division II National Poll multiple times in 2009 and 2010. In addition 5 position players signed professional baseball contracts in his two years there.

Prior to his time at Florida Southern, Corbeil was an Assistant Coach at Manatee Community College for three seasons beginning in 2006. The Lancers made three consecutive trips to the FCCAA State Tournament including two runner up finishes in 2006 and 2008.

As a player, Corbeil began his collegiate career at Manatee Community College where he played for two seasons. While at Manatee he helped lead the team to the NJCAA World Series in 1999 where they finished third. During that time he was a two time All Conference and All State selection. Corbeil continued his career at Division I Florida International University in Miami, Florida. In his only season at FIU he earned Sunbelt Conference Player of the Year, Newcomer of the Year and was named a First Team All American by Collegiate Baseball. Corbeil finished his collegiate career at Florida Southern College where he earned All-American honors. Following his collegiate career he was selected in the 16th round by the Anaheim Angels. Corbeil played seven seasons of professional baseball.

Assistant Coach Collin Martin

Collin Martin enters his second season as an Assistant Coach with Polk State College. In 2011 the Vikings offense saw eight players earn All-Conference honors, while leading the Suncoast Conference in runs scored (400), runs batted in (344), doubles (106), triples (27), total extra base hits (163), stolen bases (115), and finishing second in batting average (.289). The Vikings offense also broke several offensive records including; runs scored, runs batted in, doubles, triples, total at-bats, walks, while finishing second all-time in stolen bases.

Coach Martin, a Winter Haven native, brings high school, collegiate and professional coaching experience to the program. At PSC his responsibilities include assisting in all facets of the offense as well as handling a bulk of the recruiting responsibilities. Before joining the Polk State staff he coached one season as an assistant at Florida Southern College. While there he assisted with offensive instruction, handled outfield and base running duties and served as the First Base Coach. Prior to Florida Southern, Martin served as an assistant coach at Winter Haven High School from 2006-2009 and spent the summer of 2009 as an assistant coach with the Cotuit Kettlers of the prestigious Cape Cod League. Before making the move to high school coaching he coached professionally for the Florence Freedom of the independent Frontier League in 2007.

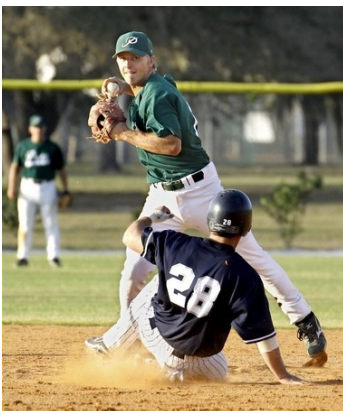
Martin played collegiate baseball at Santa Fe Community College, where he was a First Team All-Conference selection in 2004. He transferred to Webber International University for the 2005-2006 seasons. In 2006 he was a First Team All-Florida Sun Conference selection, a First Team All-Southern Region choice and a Honorable Mention NAIA All-American. After college he signed a free agent contract with the Cleveland Indians in 2006 and later with the Florence Freedom.

Assistant Coach Brad Cook

Brad Cook begins his second year as the Pitching Coach for Polk State. In 2011, the Vikings pitching staff led the Suncoast Conference in Wins (43), Losses (12), Innings (478.1), Walks (181), Saves (17), Runs (262) and Earned Run Average (3.61). Five pitchers took home All-Conference honors including two First-Team selections. In addition, closer Reid Noah was named Fireman of the Year for his state leading 11 saves. He broke the school record for appearances (29) and tied school record for saves. Three of his pitcher's earned scholarships to 4-year programs.

Before joining the Polk State staff, he served as the Pitching Coach for Florida Southern College for two seasons. Four pitchers from his staff went on to professional baseball including Daniel Tillman, second round selection of the Anaheim Angels and All-American Max Russell a fourth round selection also by the Angels. Prior to FSC, Cook was the Head Baseball Coach at Johnson City (NY) High School for two seasons. During his tenure he coached a First Team All-State Pitcher and the Class A Player of the Year in 2007.

As a player, Cook was a Junior College All-American at Keystone College (PA) before transferring to Division I Marist College (NY). While at Marist he led the team in ERA in 2002 and was named to the 2002 MAAC All-Tournament team. Following his collegiate career, he played two seasons with the Elmira Pioneers of the Independent Northeast League.

FACILITIES

Polk State College is the home of the Vikings and is considered one of the top facilities in NJCAA. You will get the chance to use this first rate Division I facility, while improving your skill and showcasing your athletic ability. In the summer of 2011, the field will continue to receive upgrades. A brand new kneeling wall and netting will be constructed for the new backstop. The dugouts' flooring and benches will receive upgrading, in addition to a new protective railing in front. A new turf halo will round out home plate. Our new two outdoor batting cages, hitting area, four new bullpen mounds and new game mound will all be used to give players maximum repetitions under the careful eye of our staff. A brand new paint job to the entire facility, in addition to a new warning track gives the field a fresh, sharp appearance. The refurbished VIP Sports Deck will be available for seating and our state of the art concession will be open for drinks and food purchase. The field dimensions: LF 330 feet, CF 390 feet and RF 330 feet.



Directions to Polk State College Baseball Field

From Orlando: Take I4 W towards Tampa. Merge onto US-27S towards Haines City via Exit 55. Turn Right onto Dundee Rd/SR-542. Turn Slight right onto E Lake Elbert Dr NE. Turn Right on 10th St NE then take 1st Left onto Avenue H NE.

From Tampa: Take I275 North to I4 East via Exit 45B toward Orlando. Take Exit 28 Toward US-92. Merge onto W Memorial Blvd. W Memorial Blvd become US-92 E. Turn slight Right onto Havendale Blvd. Turn Right onto 1st St/SR-549 S. Turn Left onto Avenue K NE. Turn Right onto Lake Martha Dr. Turn Left onto Avenue H NE.

From South Florida: Take Florida Turnpike N to exit 193 SR-60 W toward Lake Wales. Merge onto US-27 N toward Haines City. Turn Left onto Dundee Rd/SR-542. Turn Slight right onto E Lake Elbert Dr NE. Turn Right on 10th St NE then take 1st Left onto Avenue H NE.

From North Florida: Take I75 S. Merge onto Florida's Turnpike via Exit 328 toward Orlando. Take Exit 289 US-27 S. Turn Right onto Dundee Rd/SR-542. Turn Slight right onto E Lake Elbert Dr NE. Turn Right on 10th St NE then take 1st Left onto Avenue H NE.
