It's never too early or too late to think about your career choices. At the following high schools and career centers, you can earn free college credit toward an Associate of Science (AS) degree at Polk State College.

It's simple!

- 1) Enroll in one of the listed high school programs at one of the high schools listed below.
- 2) Complete the listed high school instruction with a minimum weighted grade point average of 3.0 and an overall weighted grade point average of 2.0.
- 3) Enroll in the corresponding Polk State degree or certificate program within 3 years of graduating from high school.

In addition to articulated credits from a Career Pathways program, you may also enroll in Polk State's Dual Enrollment Program to receive even more free credits toward your degree. Check with your high school guidance counselor or a Polk State College advisor to see if you are eligible, if courses are available at your high school, or whether you might attend classes at Polk State College. - Students must request articulated credits within 3 years of graduating from high school. All credits will be transcribed as credit-by-exam.
- Students must complete the required secondary program curriculum with a 3.0 or better GPA and a minimum 2.0 overall graduating GPA
- Students must complete assessment testing required by Polk State College.
- Students must apply to Polk State, meet the college's admission requirements, and complete 3 credits at Polk State before high school credits will be transcribed.
- This agreement is between Polk State College and the Polk County School Board. Articulated credits will count toward your Polk State degree but may not transfer to other colleges if you do not first graduate from Polk State.
- This agreement is currently in effect, but may change in the future. Always confirm current program agreements with your high school guidance counselor or a Polk State advisor.
