The purpose of this rule is to provide an operational policy by which charges for admission may be established for certain college programs, activities, and events.

1. Activities and Events Defined

Special programs, activities, and/or events will be scheduled as part of the total Polk State College program. In order to help offset expenses, authority is granted to establish charges for admission in accordance with the provisions of this policy for the following types of activity:

- A. Intercollegiate sports
- B. Special athletic events, such as tournaments
- C. Special presentations of College groups, such as plays and exhibits
- D. Professional performances and exhibits contracted for with outside agencies

2. Charges for Admission and Reports

- A. The President is authorized to establish reasonable charges for admission to the various classifications of events described above. Polk State College students, employees, and Board members will be admitted without charge to all events except specified fundraising events. Rule 5.04 and Procedure 6070 allow for charges if the event is a fundraiser for student groups.
- B. The President is authorized to waive admission charges for individuals and groups in connection with student recruiting or college promotion objectives.
- C. The President is authorized to suspend charges for admission to the various classifications of events when administrative review determines that the administrative costs of collection and accounting are greater than the revenue.
