FALL CLASSES & SCHEDULING

All FALL Classes for Polk State College and Polk State Lakeland Gateway to College Collegiate High School will be virtual classes. What does that mean? Our instructors on the high school side and those who may teach college classes will provide instruction for the students virtual via Canvas, Plato (Edmentum) and other methods that they choose to use. Those who have college courses, PLEASE be sure that you are closely reading the course syllabi for what the instructors are requiring. We provide all materials that you will need for your classes, please be that these materials are picked up during the scheduled times for textbook pick-up (for college courses only).

Mrs. Chandler will be emailing schedules before August 3, 2020. Some of you will have a full college schedule, some of you will have a college and high school blended schedule and some may have just a full high school schedule depending upon your goals. If you've not taken the Pert, please be sure to do so by July 31, 2020. While Pert is not required to be admitted to Gateway, it is required to have scores on file. Some of you may notice that although you haven't passed the Pert, you have some college courses. Here at Gateway we have a few courses that we can offer without having passing Pert scores, and there was a directive from the Governor of the State of Florida that will allow for the FALL semester those who have an unweighted GPA of at least a 3.0 to take dual enrolled college courses. Please note that we will use our discretion when scheduling to ensure that you get what you NEED for high school graduation FIRST! Please note that no student can register themselves, only Mrs. Chandler or Dr. Downing-Townsend can schedule you.





Canvas mail IS NOT your my.polk.edu email. Canvas mail is used if we need to send announcements. Canvas mail is used to communicate with some instructors, please confirm method of communication via course syllabus. Canvas is not to be used as your main method of communicating. We are empowering you to use your my.polk.edu email accounts.





If we call the telephone number that' on your Polk State College Profile, will it ring to you or your parent(s)? Students and parents, please be sure that your Polk State College Profile has the Students phone number listed. Emergency alerts are sent to the number listed. If we need to contact the student via phone immediately, it won't work if mom or dads' number is listed. To change that information, please log into Passport.



THE BAND APP

Dr. Downing-Townsend sent emails to all students and parents inviting them to join their respective bands. The Parent Band is solely for the parents and the Student Band is solely for the students. Students will be invited to other Bands such as classes, mentoring, club, etc.... It's important that ALL students join the Band app. This app can be accessed via a mobile phone or a web access. Students who don't join the Band app for communication will miss a lot of valuable information. In the Band we've posted how to videos, welcome videos, career videos and much more! Haven't joined? Email Dr. Downing-Townsend TODAY!

Band App Protocol:

- Please be mindful that when you send a
 message that's not directed to one person, it
 goes to everyone. Try to direct your messages
 to one person and private message that one
 person. This reduces the amount of whole group
 messages.
- Please read and watch videos in the band before asking a question as it probably has already been answered via video or a separate post.
- 3. Please ONLY send messages between the hours of 8:00AM 5:00PM. Remember our faculty and staff have families outside of the work hours.
- 4. Please allow for up to 24 hours for a response when asking a question.
- 5. Please be sure to follow the instructions of First and last names on your personal Band for students. Parents, please be sure to list your name and the students name as your profile name. We are aware that some names are longer than others and not all will fit.
- If you elect NOT TO join the Band app, please make sure you have a buddy to get pertinent information from.
- If you have questions regarding the Band app, please contact Dr. Downing-Townsend or Mrs. Chandler.



EMAIL

Your my.polk.edu email should be a MAJOR part of your educational experience while with us at Gateway. MANY of the emails that you'll receive from instructors, office staff or the college in general will come from your my.polk.edu email account. PLEASE SEE THE VIDEO IN BAND ON HOW TO CHECK YOUR my.polk.edu email account.

Don't miss deadlines, responses, events, class cancellations, etc. because you didn't access your email. Please check your email at least once or twice a day. FOCUS is the system that is used to maintain your high school records.

This system is where you will see your current and final grades in high school courses. FOCUS will show your schedule once it's posted and it's where you can see all your testing data and graduation requirements.

STUDENTS, once you've been loaded into our system your username for FOCUS will be your Polk State college my.polk.edu email address and your password will be your Polk State College ID Number with a capital letter at the beginning.

If you try to access it now and can't get in, you may not be in our system yet. Please allow us until next Friday to have all current new students enrolled.



PASSPORT is the system that is used to maintain your college records. NO HIGH SCHOOL DATA WILL APPEAR IN

THIS SYSTEM. This system is where you can look up college courses, see your college course schedule, college grades at the end of the semester, your Polk State college email address, your degree audit if you're working towards an AA or AS degree and much more as it pertains to the college. This is also where you can update your personal information for the college, i.e. address and phone number.

PARENTS, there is no separate access allowed for you on this system as it's a college system. Your student would have to show you the information. (A video has been posted into the Band app on how to access this system).

If you get locked out of the Passport system or need to reset your my.polk.edu email password, please contact the Help Desk at 863-298-6839. Gateway staff does not have the ability to reset any passwords, etc.



Canvas is the system where the Gateway shell is located. In the Gateway shell is where you can find scholarship opportunities, the volunteer form, the mentoring list, and

much more.

This system is also where the college courses and maybe a few high school courses will have shells. The college course shells will typically have modules where your work is housed for those classes, list your up to date grades and more.

If high school instructors use Canvas, they will have a shell and includes assignments, grates, etc.... Be sure to check your course Canvas shells daily as instructors will often post information. Canvas also has a link to the TLCC for tutoring in every course shell. Please use the Gateway shell link for high school course tutoring. A few videos on how to navigate Canvas is in the Band app.

New & Returning Student Orientation - "It's VIRTUAL!"

On July 31, 2020 we will hold a virtual orientation. What will this look like you might ask? We will post to the Band app a video entailing a lot of information for our students and parents by 1PM. This video will allow you to go back and revisit information that you may have missed or forgotten or need clarification. Our orientation will have information on the following:
