

**How to apply to Polk State Chain of Lakes Collegiate High School
for the 2025-26 School Year
Enrollment closes **March 7, 2025****

1. Apply to Polk State College

- Student Status: Dual-Enrollment
- Start Term – Fall 2025

Allow 3-5 days to receive your Welcome Email from Polk State College.

2. Schedule and take the PERT test:

Once you receive the Polk State College Welcome Email, you can move forward with testing. You will need to provide your Polk State College student ID number provided in your Welcome Email to take the PERT. Click the link below to schedule your PERT at Chain of Lakes Collegiate Highschool. 3. Required Test Scores:

Incoming 10th grade Applicants (current 9th graders):

PERT: Reading 92, Writing 92, Math 100

All 3 required sections met

Incoming 11th grade Applicants (current 10th graders):

May provide the scores from the following exams:

PSAT10 or SAT: Reading 24, Writing 25, Math 24

ACT: Reading 19, Writing 17, Math 19

PERT: Reading 106, Writing 103, Math 114

2 out of 3 required sections met

4. Obtain Transcript or Student Course History:

- **Polk County Public Schools**- Students with access to the Student Portal (Focus) may obtain a record online, or you may obtain this information from your school counselor.
- **Non-Polk County Public Schools**-Students will obtain a transcript or student academic record from their school counselor/records office.

Once you obtain your high school transcript/course history, proceed to step 5.

5. Apply to Chain of Lakes Collegiate High School:

You must use your Polk State College email to access the high school application. The following documents are needed to complete application:

- Test scores
- High school course history or high school transcript.
