

Associate in Science (AS) Emergency Medical Services

This Program Map is Part of the Health Sciences Pathway

This Program Map is for students who plan to earn an AS degree in Emergency Medical Services at Polk State College. It has been designed to illustrate the fastest path to your degree. You can complete pre-requisite and general education courses as your schedule permits. EMS courses are listed in the order in which they must be completed. Students should always meet with their Student Success Advisor to develop a personalized Educational Plan.

Students earn the Emergency Medical Technology Certificate and the Paramedic Certificate as part of the AS degree in Emergency Medical Services. Students may also pursue and earn these certificates separately from the AS degree. The Emergency Medical Technology Certificate has pre-requisites to entry. The Paramedic Certificate is a limited admission program. Students must complete pre-requisite courses, meet all program admission requirements and criteria, and submit a program application. A Few Notes:

- 1. Students must meet all graduation requirements. To learn more about graduation requirements, please refer to the College Catalog.
- 2. Students may complete BSC 2085C and BSC 2086C instead of BSC 1084C. Students interested in pursuing other health professions in the future should consider completing BSC 2085C and BSC 2086C instead of BSC 1084C.



- 3. Students must have completed EMS 1059C, an approved transfer course, or the Emergency Medical Responder program at Ridge Technical College to enroll in the Emergency Medical Technology Certificate program. Students who complete the Emergency Medical Responder program at Ridge Technical College are eligible to enroll in the Emergency Medical Technology Certificate program but will not receive credit for EMS 1059C.
- 4. Students must hold a valid Florida Emergency Medical Technology Certificate to be admitted to the Paramedic Certificate program. Students must also complete BSC 1084C or BSC 2085C and BSC 2086C. Although not required for program admission, completion of ENC 1101, HUM 2020, and PSY 2012 is considered as part of the program admission process. - 5. Students must earn an appropriate score on a placement examination or complete MAT 1100 in order to enroll in MGF 1106.
