Description:	Students will be provided with instruction on the importance of surveillance principles, discuss mobile (vehicle) surveillance, stationary surveillance, foot surveillance techniques, aircraft surveillance techniques and electronic surveillance techniques. This class will also discuss equipment that should be utilized to enhance surveillance and discuss report writing while conducting surveillance. Student will participate in field exercises that will include conducting actual surveillance.
