Required prerequisite courses: The following courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better:

- 1. ENC 1101 College Composition I
- 2. BSC 2085C Human Anatomy and Physiology I (**Must be taken within 5 years of application)
- 3. BSC 2086C Human Anatomy and Physiology II (**Must be taken within 5 years of application)
- 4. One of the following: POS 2041 American National Government, or AMH 1020 AMH 1020 History of the United States: 1877 to the Present, or AMH 1010 History of the United States: 1607-1877
- 5. One of the following: MGF 1130 Mathematical Thinking, STA 2023 Introduction to Probability and Statistics, or MAC 1105 College Algebra
