Application Period May 1 – May 31 of every year**

Required prerequisite courses: The following courses must be completed with a grade of “C” or better:

1. ENC 1101 – College Composition I
2. BSC 2085C – Human Anatomy and Physiology I (**Must be taken within 5 years of application)
3. BSC 2086C Human Anatomy and Physiology II (**Must be taken within 5 years of application)
4. One of the following: POS 2041 – American National Government, or AMH 1020 AMH 1020 – History of the United States: 1877 to the Present, or AMH 1010 – History of the United States: 1607-1877
5. One of the following: MGF 1130 Mathematical Thinking, STA 2023 Introduction to Probability and Statistics, or MAC 1105 College Algebra

- ☐ Official Transcript verifying prerequisite courses with a GPA 2.5 or higher (must indicate if you are currently enrolled in any pre-requisite courses)
- ☐ Official transcripts from ALL colleges/universities attended
- ☐ Observation Hours Verified and Signed on program's forms (minimum of 10 hours required)
- ☐ Essay on why you want to become a Physical Therapist Assistant
- ☐ Proof of informational session
- ☐ Verification of: other Health license(s) or certificate(s) (if applicable), health care employment with supervisor and employment information (if applicable), and/or military service DD21 (if applicable).
