A friendly reminder that only essential personnel are allowed on campus to prevent the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19). Polk State's leadership team is monitoring the rapidly evolving situation closely and responding as quickly as possible with daily communication among the leadership team, with the Florida Department of Education, and guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

### All high school classes for the remainder of the Spring term and all college classes for the summer will be completely ONLINE.

Additionally, the College is following the CDC's guideline for large events and mass gatherings which recommends canceling or postponing in-person events that consist of more than 10 people. 




Students if you have college books to return or Summer books to pick-up please follow the schedule and process; we want to ensure the safety of all:
