### A Few Notes:

- 1. Pursuant to Rule 6A-10.02413 of the Florida Administrative Code, all degree-seeking students must demonstrate competency in civic literacy by both passing the Florida Civic Literacy Exam and by completion of AMH 1010 (History of the United States: 1607-1877), AMH 1020 (History of the United States: 1877 to the Present) or POS 2041 (American National Government). Students may also use AP or CLEP credit for one of the threecourse options.
- 2. TPP1290L Technical Theatre must be completed one time for the Theatre Pathway and can be taken up to four times for credit.
- 3. Students need two natural sciences general education courses. One must include a lab.

- 4. TPP1190L Rehearsal and Performance is offered most terms in connection with a college production can be completed up to four times for credit as an elective.
- 5. The AA degree requires the completion of 60 credit hours, including 36 credit hours of General Education courses and 24 credit hours of elective courses. This transfer intent requires the completion of additional courses in order to meet all pre-requisites for admission into a bachelor's degree program at a state university. These additional courses are in excess of required program hours and may not be covered by financial aid. Students should speak to their Student Success Advisor for more information.


