- Must be a Polk County High School senior or incoming freshman wishing to pursue a degree in music and attend Polk State College
- Must be a full-time student each semester (12 credit hours or more)
- Must commit to participate in at least one major vocal ensemble at the College each semester

Application Requirements:

- Acceptance to Polk State College
- Grade point average of 3.0 or higher
- Two letters of recommendation; one from a high school or church music director and one from an academic instructor or pastor
- Essay on the importance of music to the applicant, addressing their experiences and future with music
