CRIMINAL HISTORY

All applicants are required to go through the fingerprinting process for the academy per 943.14 (7) FSS. Processing of fingerprints is a mandatory and **NON-REFUNDABLE \$56.25**.

APPLICANT SCREENING FEE: \$100.00 – Due when the Law Enforcement application is submitted & is mandatory & NON-REFUNDABLE.

TESTING

All applicants must take the **Basic Abilities Test (BAT)**, as mandated by 943.17(1)(g) FSS. This test is given the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month. You must register for the test and pay the **NON-REFUNDABLE** exam fee of **\$45.00** prior to the date the test is administered. **NOTE: You must pass the Basic Abilities Test in order for the application process to continue.**

Polygraph Examination: The applicant will be responsible for scheduling their polygraph exam, with an IPS approved polygraphist upon completion of a pre-screening application. **\$115 NON-REFUNDABLE.**

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

A complete physical examination, including an EKG, is required of each applicant and must be done, by an approved licensed physician. A 7-panel drug screen is also required. The forms supplied by IPS **must be utilized**. The results of the examinations and the drug screen must be submitted to the IPS along with the application. **\$125**
