As a student...

- Am I mature enough to handle a flexible schedule and less structure?
- Am I eager to engage in the school culture academically and socially?
- Am I willing to plan carefully for post-secondary transition? Clubs!!
- Am I willing to regularly check emails, texts and other important school messages in order to be an informed student?
- If I have an IEP or 504, I will work closely with CHS and Polk State to self-advocate for needed accommodations

As a parent...

- Am I willing to accept that I cannot speak directly with college professors (meetings, phone calls, emails, etc.) about my child's grades/progress due to FERPA laws? (FERPA handout)
- Am I willing to support my child and hold them accountable for their progress and grades? Student Canvas!
- Am I willing to participate in mandatory school orientations, meetings and events and to complete surveys to provide feedback to the school?

CHS contracts with Polk State's on campus food service program to provide lunch for students who qualify for F/R lunch. All students have access to purchase food on campus.


Canteen App!


