TESTING

February 22-24 – FSA Writing and Reading. (For students who have not met their FSA Reading requirement. ALL three days are MANDATORY) **Location** - TBD

March 8-9 - FSA Algebra 1 EOC. For students who have not met their FSA Algebra 1 requirement. Both days are MANDATORY) Location – TBD

March 29-31 – ACT-NCR School Day (For SENIORS ONLY who HAVE NOT passed their FSA Reading Requirement and/or FSA Algebra 1 EOC requirement) Location - TBD

April 13 – SAT School Day (ONLY 56 spots, the first 15 spots will go to those seniors who HAVE NOT passed their FSA Reading Requirement and/or FSA Algebra 1 EOC requirement. The remaining 41 spots are first come first served. Location - TBD

April 19 - ACT School Day (For <u>JUNIORS</u> <u>ONLY</u>. Any Junior who wants to test can test) Location - TBD

April 26 – SAT School Day (ONLY 56 spots, First Come, First Served) <mark>If you sign up for</mark> testing on April 13, you <u>CANNOT</u> sign up for April 26 testing, Location - TBD

May 2 – Civics Test (For ANY student who had Mrs. McIntosh for US Government this year). **Location** – TBD

May 3 – US History EOC (For any student currently enrolled in the US History Course.)

May 9-10 – Geometry EOC (For those who are currently enrolled in the Geometry Course).
