Polk State College District Board of Trustees Considering Changes in Non-Resident Distance Learning Tuition and Fees for 2024/25

Winter Haven — The Polk State College District Board of Trustees (DBOT) will consider non-resident tuition and fees for distance learning for the 2024/25 academic year at the August 1, 2024, Board Meeting which will be held at 4:30 p.m. in Room 267 at the Polk State Center for Public Safety.

Polk State College has been approved by the Florida Legislature to participate in a pilot program to offer select online degree programs to non-resident students at an inclusive rate for tuition and fees not to exceed \$290 per credit hour. This is a decrease in the current non-resident tuition and fee rate of \$409.06 per credit hour and will only apply to select online degree programs beginning the 2024/25 academic year.
