# ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN POLK STATE COLLEGE AND

### Lakeland Regional Health

This agreement is entered into this date by Polk State College and Lakeland Regional Health. The two parties agree to articulate the Radiography Program at LRH to Polk State College's AS degree in Radiography under the stipulations hereafter outlined.

A student from the LRH Radiography Program who seeks an AS degree at Polk State College under this articulation:

- 1. Is required to complete 25% of the program hours at Polk State College. (See table of qualifying hours below.) The student must take a minimum of 20 credits (25% of the Polk State College Radiography Program) in residence at Polk State College from the qualifying list below to qualify for graduation. The Registrar's Office will review the transcript to confirm that the student can meet the resident credit requirement.
- 2. Must graduate from LRH before any credits are articulated to the student's Polk State College record.
