Parents/Students will be receiving letters with scheduled testing dates for students who have not passed or received a concordant score for the FSA Reading and Algebra 1 EOC. In March 2020, Governor DeSantis suspended all spring assessments for K-12 public schools. Testing will resume with make-up sessions starting September 16 for the FSA Reading as a three-day exam and October 8 for the Algebra 1 EOC as a two-day exam. Up to 14 students will be placed in a computer lab to ensure health and safety procedures are met. Students will need to communicate with their professors and/or employers regarding their scheduled test date(s). These assessments satisfy graduation requirements.
