Education Educator Preparation Institute Instructions

Each teacher candidate is **required to submit all required documents** to be considered for admission in the Educator Preparation Institute (EPI). The candidate will be emailed regarding enrollment approval after all documents are reviewed internally.

Applicants must hold a minimum of a bachelor's degree in a field outside of Education, have a passing Subject Area Exam, and a valid Statement of Status of Eligibility to be considered for acceptance.

Part I—College Admission/Registrar Requirements (1-4)

I. Complete the Polk State College Application for enrollment. www.polk.edu click "APPLY NOW"

II.. Submit all official college transcripts to the Polk State Registrar's Office. **Completed:** _____

What is the process to evaluate my transcripts from previous institutions? There are two stages of transcript evaluation:

Stage One – The initial evaluation is entering all transfer work onto your Polk State College record. Takes approximately one week from receipt of your previous institution's transcript.

Stage Two – Mapping your transfer work to Polk State courses and degrees. Takes approximately six weeks from the initial evaluation of your previous institution's transcript.

How do I know if my transcripts have arrived or are evaluated? What do I do if they are not here? Look at your [Passport](#) account often to watch for your transcript evaluations and contact us at registrar@polk.edu.

I understand that I can watch for my official transcript arrival via my PASSPORT account. initial here:

Student ID: Use your Social Security Number or the Student ID that was mailed to you when you applied.

PIN #: Use the PIN (Personal Identification Number) that was mailed to you when you first applied.

You are advised to change your PIN during your first use. If you do not have the information you need to log in or have difficulty doing so, please contact us at 863-297-1000.

- You ordered a transcript more than 7 days from the date the transferring institution tells you it was sent, and it is not showing as received.

III. Does Polk State need ALL my past postsecondary transcripts? Yes, regardless of age or accreditation, you are required to submit all transcripts from all previously attended institutions.

IV. Complete the Polk State **New Student Orientation (online)**. This orientation is required before the teacher candidate may be officially admitted by the college.

V. Complete and submit the **Florida Residency Declaration with 2 proof of Florida residency** to the college's Etrieve system. **Completed:** _____

Do you currently have, from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE), a Temporary Teaching Certificate or a Statement of Eligibility stating you are eligible for a temporary? Yes____, No____. **If you answered NO, you are not eligible for EPI at this time.**

{The current application fee is \$75 per subject area. The candidate receives a Statement of Status of Eligibility (SOE) 4 to 8 weeks after the application is submitted.}

EDUCATOR PREPARATION INSTITUTE INSTRUCTIONS

Brief descriptions of the four program approval standards are as follows:

- *Standard 1* concentrates on the quality of selection for teacher candidates admitted to the program.

1. Prospective candidates must submit a brief written introduction of themselves and a writing sample following the requirements listed below. This must be submitted to the program coordinator via email and will be filed in the candidate's individual electronic folder.

The writing sample should be a biographical statement that addresses the following questions:

A. Why do you want to become a K-12 teacher?

B. What skills and personal qualities do you possess that you believe will help you become an "excellent" teacher?

C. This program requires time commitment to complete the course work and applying practical applications. It also requires a commitment to complete Field Experience/intern with a teacher for 60+ hours that we place you with, to co-teach, teach several lessons on your own following lesson plans and meeting the objectives of the lessons and assessing students in a formal manner. You will be monitored and for your teaching skills, use of teaching strategies, Higher Order Questioning to expand or stretch student critical thinking skills, applications of accommodations, use of differentiation, and other pedagogical aspects that will all be critiqued as to your readiness as a teacher. What are your strategies for the time commitment required to learn, apply, and meet these obligations?

Type your letter 1 1/5 page to a maximum of 3 page; double spaced using 12-point font. Include your name, student I.D. number, email, and phone number in upper left corner.

Email your letter to Mrs. Davis at sdavis@polk.edu and it will be reviewed.

Grammar and spelling will also be checked. This letter is a very important part of the judgment for acceptance and not all applicants may be accepted.

- a. It is important that you retrieve the free study material available at the website given in the instructions found at the link above. A score of 80 or above is required to indicate knowledge of Reading Fundamentals to allow student's the background knowledge for EPI Reading 2. Those who do not score 80% or higher will be required to register and complete the 4 week online Reading Fundamental \$50 workshop. **Completed:** _____

- b. Complete the EPI Entrance Interview** at: <https://www.polk.edu/educator-preparation-institute/>
Once there, click on the tab labeled “**EPI Entrance Interview**” and this will take you to the EPI Application in Etrieve. Complete the application fully and use the icon of the paperclip to **upload ALL Required Documents**. Applications denied for lack of completion or lack of required documents will have to be filled out a second time to resubmit.

3. Submit a copy of the **Statement of Status of Eligibility (SOE)** that authorizes eligibility for a temporary teaching certificate with your EPI application (required for entry). Scan any paper versions of the required documents (using a smart phone app, scanner, or a copy machine) save as pdf before uploading. **Completed:** _____

4. Submit a copy of the **Temporary Teaching certificate** (if you are teaching) and a SIGNED Principal's **Formal Evaluation** of your teaching along with your EPI Entrance Interview.

4. Submit the Florida Teacher Certification Exam (FTCE) **Subject Area Test scores** (required for entry). The current testing fee is \$200 per subject area. A record of the score must be submitted with the EPI Entrance Interview. **Completed:** _____
