Student Achievement Data

To ensure it is effectively fulfilling its mission, the College uses multiple methods to measure and document student achievement, including:

- Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) Outcome Measure –
 (This is a cohort driven, eight-year measure of student completion that is
 collected annually by the federal government.)
- 2. Institutional Goals (Specific institutional goals that address retention, completion, and student success.)
- 3. Florida Education & Training Placement Information Program Reports (This is a data collection and consumer reporting system established by Florida Statutes F.S. 1008.39 to provide follow-up data on former student and program participants who have graduated, exited, or completed a public education or training program within the State of Florida.)

IPEDS Outcome Measure - Eight-Year Graduation Rate

The IPEDS Outcome Measure (OM) survey component provides the award and enrollment statuses of four degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate student cohorts and eight sib-cohorts at degree-granting institutions. Student completion awards are collected at four-year, six-year, and eight-year status points after students have entered the institution. The 2023 IPEDS Data Feedback Report demonstrates the College's graduation rates as compared to the comparison group average for all full-time, first-time degree/certificate seeking undergraduate students within 150% of normal time to program completion.
