ENTRY FORM AND RULES

- Students can enter multiple categories, but are limited to 5 pieces total. Categories include:
 Ceramics, Design, Drawing, Mixed Media, Painting, Photography, Sculpture
 - Maximum of three pieces per category. Artworks submitted are not guaranteed in the show. <u>The show is</u>
 competitive and will be curated by the Visual Art faculty.
- The artist is responsible for delivery and pick-up of their artwork to galleries by the date listed above. The Gallery hours are Mon-Thursday 10am-2pm. If you need to make special arrangements for drop off email hscoggins@Polk.edu or submit your artwork to an art professor. Artwork MUST have forms attached.
- For submission, your work MUST be display-ready, i.e. framed, wired, and ready to hang. Your work must include wire, hanger, and backing. For assistance with framing/matting/wiring, contact one of the art professors. If your work is not properly framed it can be removed from the exhibition at the discretion of the faculty.
- Artwork must have been created in the last two years and should not have been previously exhibited at a Polk State College
 exhibition.
- Entrant must be a current Polk State College Student to be eligible. Students from any campus are eligible
 - You do not have to be enrolled in an art class to enter.
- After the last day of the exhibition, the artist will have one week to pick up their entries from the Art Gallery and sign out their artwork. Polk State is not responsible for student artwork after this deadline.
- Polk State will take due care in handling the artwork; beyond this, Polk State is not responsible for damages to any artwork caused during transit, storage, or installation. Basic insurance is provided for the artworks during the exhibition dates.
- By submitting your artwork to this exhibition, you are permitting Polk State College to use the image(s) of your artwork for publication and/or advertising purposes.
- Awards will be given at the discretion of the judge.
- Please fill out all requested information on both parts of this form for each entry. By signing, you agree with the entry rules
 of this exhibition.
- *Fill out both forms below with the same information. Top portion is turned into professor or gallery assistant. Cut bottom portion and tape to the back of the artwork. You must include a value for insurance purposes. If not for sale write NFS.
