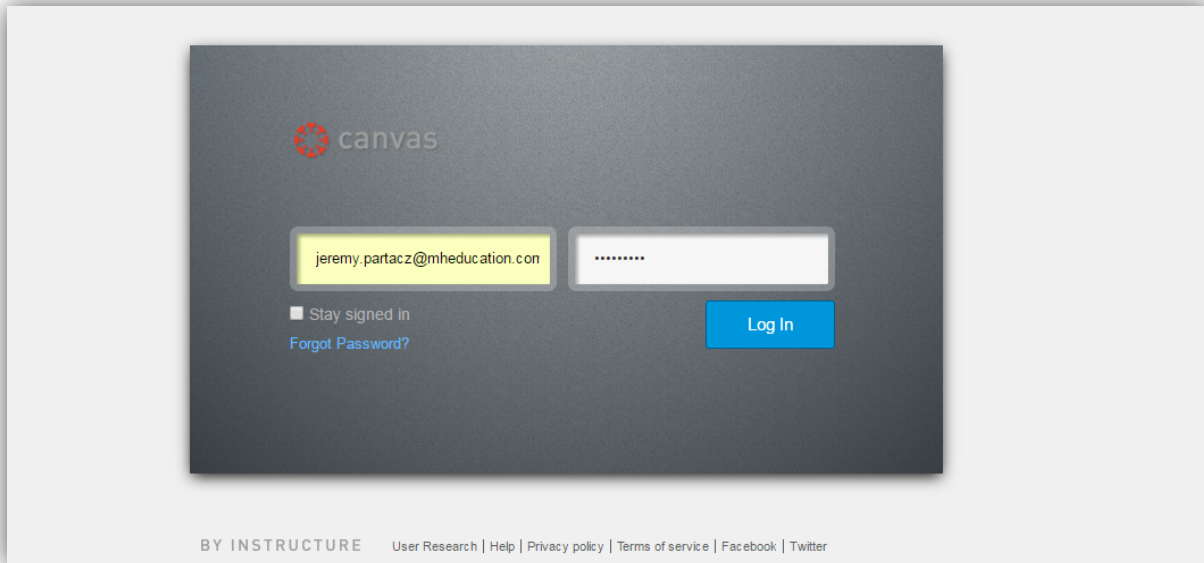




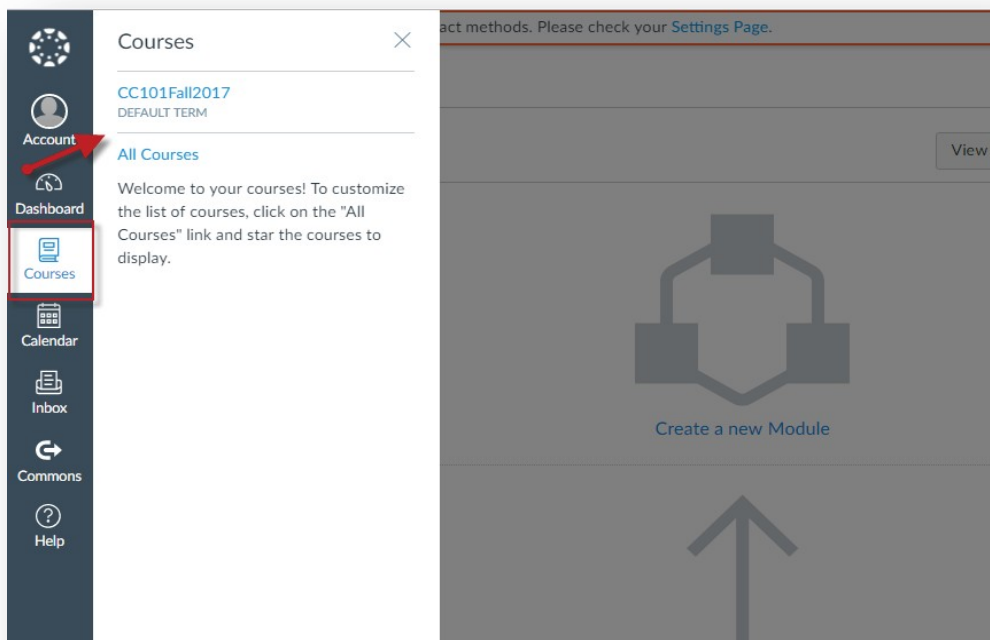

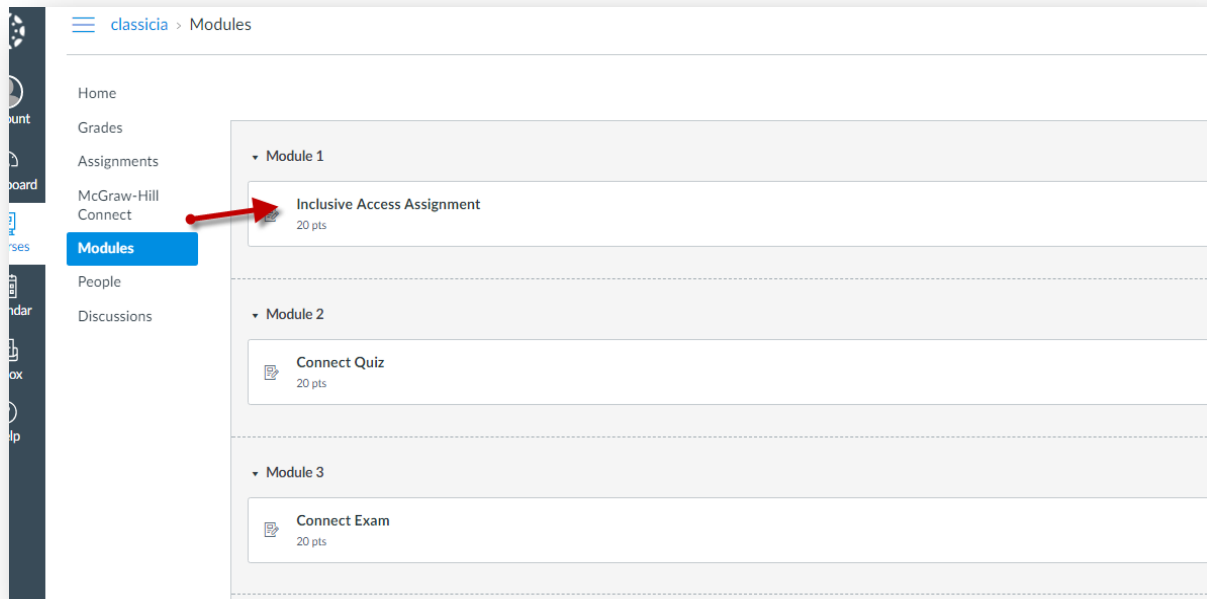
Step 1: Sign into Canvas account.



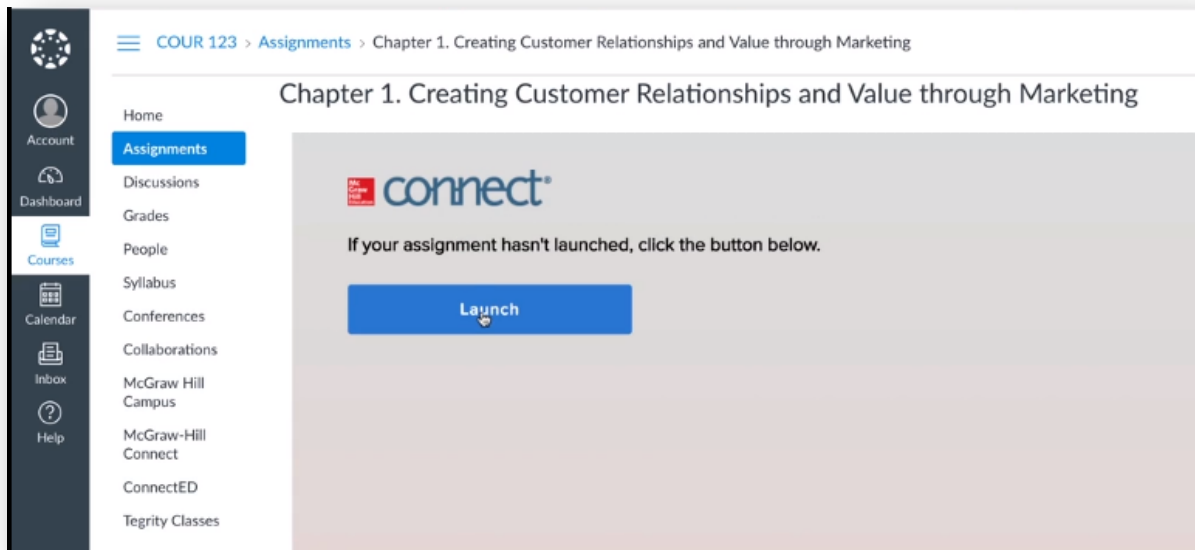
Step 2: Under Courses, locate and click on the name of your Canvas course.




Step 3: Under Modules or Assignments, locate and click on the McGraw-Hill Connect assignment link to begin.



Step 4: If prompted, click on **Launch**.




Step 5: Enter your email address.

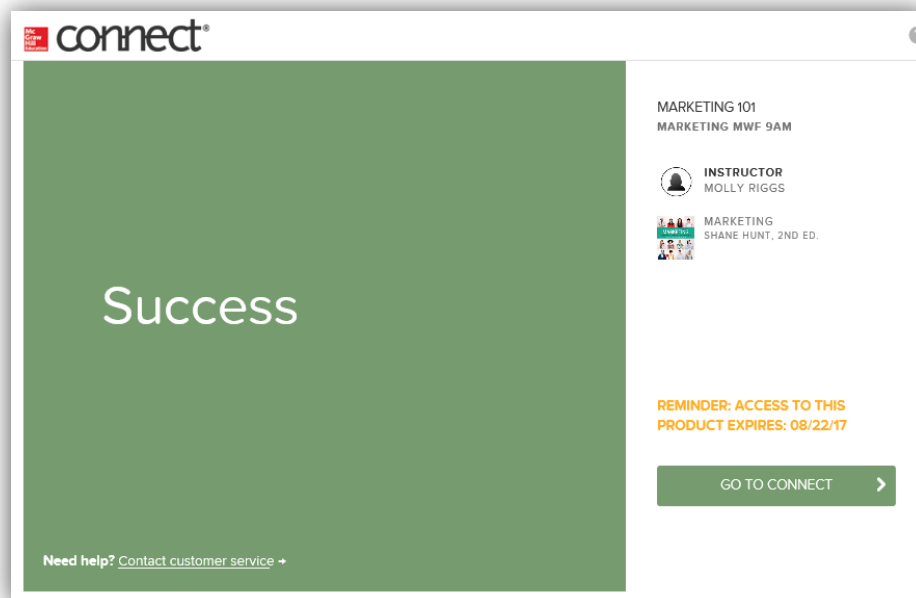

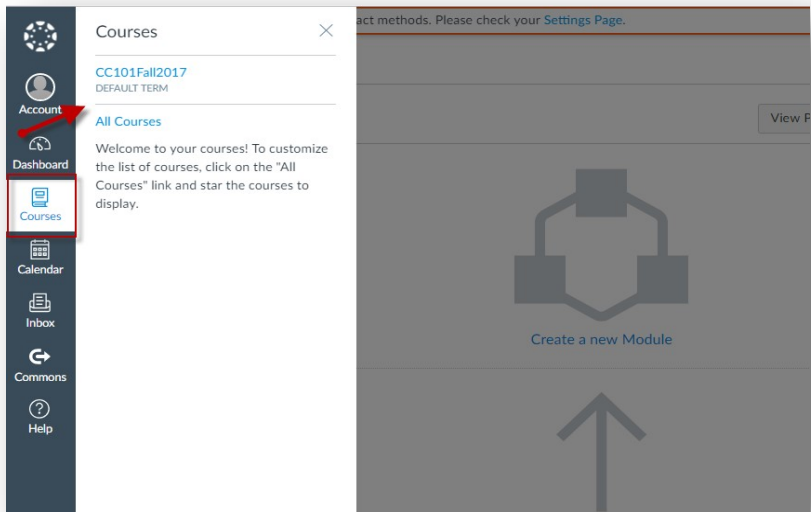
In order to complete the registration process, follow the instructions below. You will need:

- A Connect Math hosted by ALEKS account (if you already have one, if not you will create one)

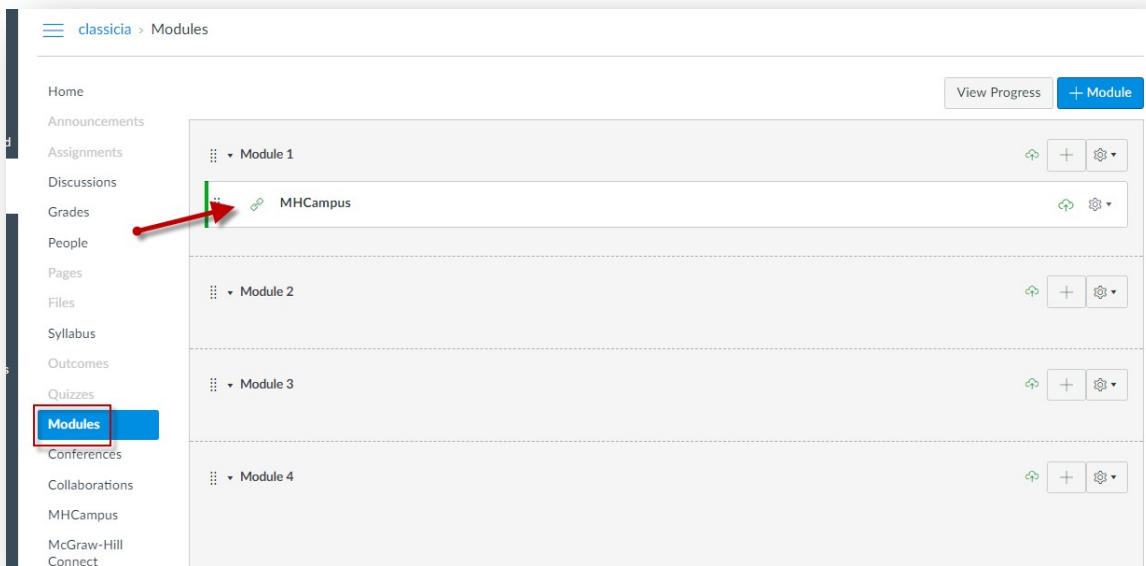
Step 1: Log into Canvas.



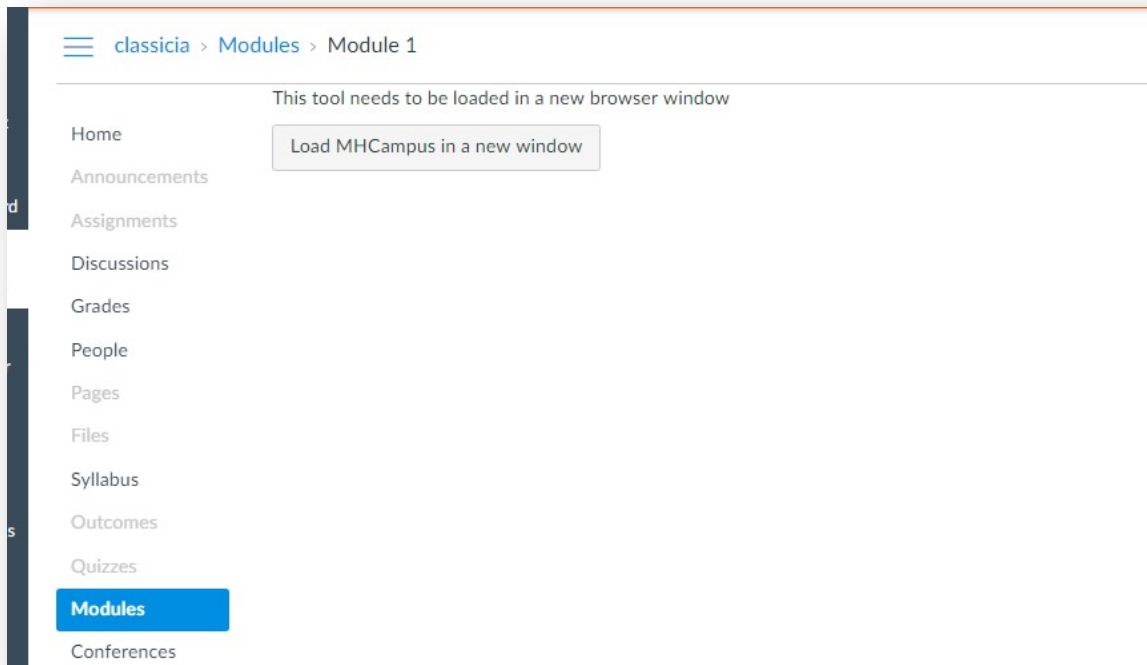
Step 2: Under Courses, locate and click on the name of your Canvas course.



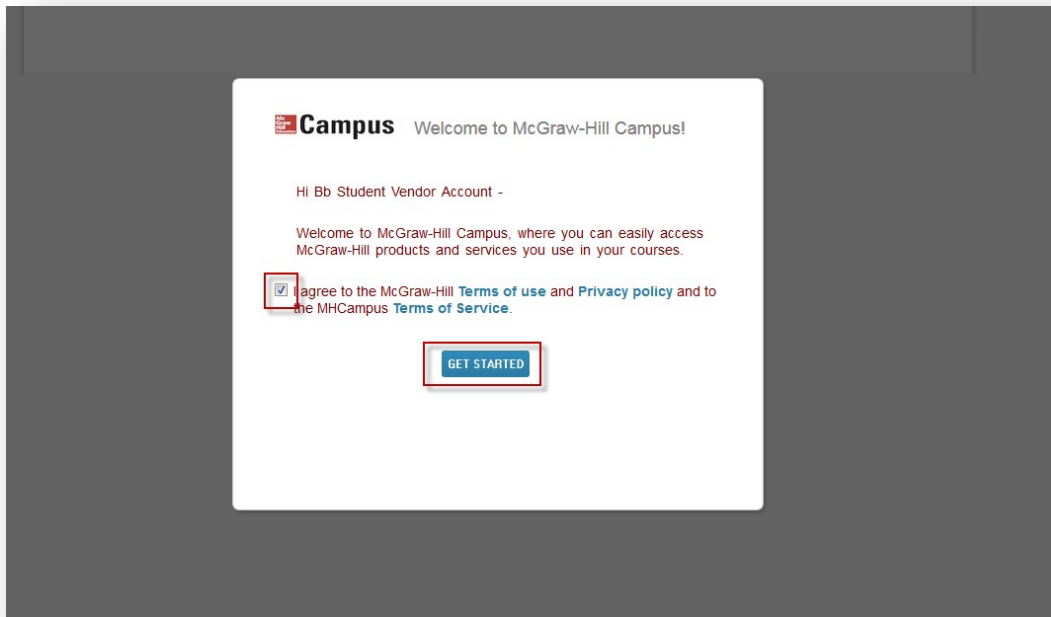
Step 3: Under the course **Modules**, locate and click on the McGraw-Hill Campus tool link.



*Click on Load McGraw Hill Campus in a new window.

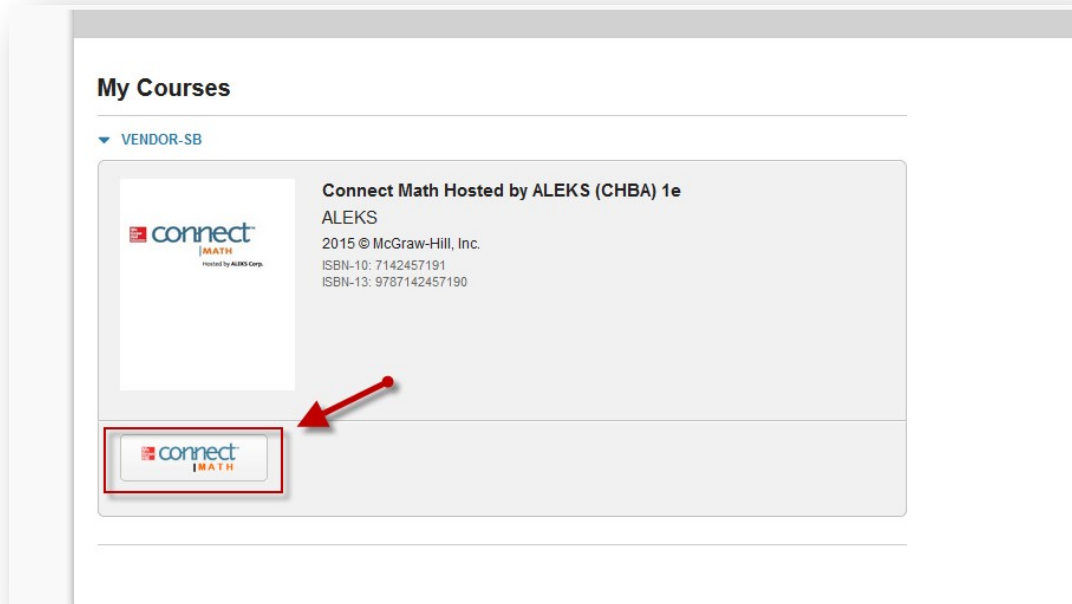


Step 4: Upon your initial launch only, agree to the terms of use; then, click Get Started.



*If an **existing** user, you will omit this step (as you only need to accept the terms of use one time).

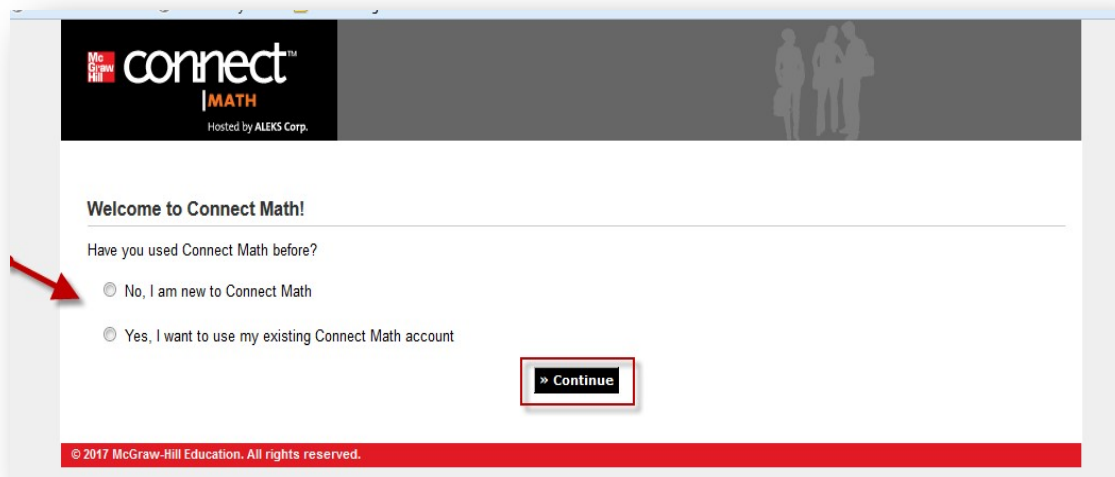
Step 5: Click on the **Connect Math** product button.
