## FOR STUDENTS

- Must have a minimum of 11 high school credits to apply
- Graduate with at least 9 college credits
- Grading based on a 4.0 GPA scale
- Honors courses earn an extra 0.5 quality point
- College courses earn an extra 1.0 quality point
- All courses are included in class rank based on weighted GPA
