Principal's Corner

Welcome and welcome back to Polk State Lakeland Gateway to College Collegiate High School. As we begin this new semester 2023 please be sure that you are starting off right by:

- 1. Making sure that you are in your respective Band. We post a lot of information there and some of you have missed it.
- 2. Make sure that you are checking your emails frequently (your my.polk.edu email). CANVAS mail, IS NOT your email. There is a difference between the two. If you need assistance with Canvas, Passport or your email, please contact Mrs. Arthi Bonney (abonney@my.polk.edu)
- 3. ATTENDANCE is extremely IMPORTANT. Parents we only accept (3) THREE parent notes/emails. We DO NOT accept phone calls. Any excuses after three must be medical, court, etc... Notes go to Mrs. Murray (clmurray@polk.edu). For those who have excessive absences in high school classes, you will be required to take a comprehensive exam at the end of the semester (NO EXCEPTIONS). If you have excessive absences in college classes, you may be dropped from college classes.
- 4. Meeting at least once per week with your mentor is vitally IMPORTANT! If you are not sure who your mentor is, please let me know and I will be more than happy to let you know.
- 5. The school calendar has MANY important dates, including student meetings. Attending student meetings are VERY IMPORTANT. Please be sure that you are in attendance for student meetings that are typically held on early release days. (Please see the school calendar and plan accordingly)



6. Communicating with high school teachers and college professors, and the Gateway office is <u>vital.</u> Be sure that you are clearly communicating any issues, concerns, difficulties, etc... at the time that it is needed. We are here to help, but we can't help if we don't know. There are many resources available to you.

7. When Gateway has testing, some is voluntary and some is involuntary. Voluntary testing is SAT and ACT school day with Gateway (unless you haven't met your graduation reading or Algebra 1 requirement). FSA reading and Algebra 1 EOC is MANDATORY if you haven't met that graduation requirement. US History EOC, Geometry EOC, Biology EOC and Civics exams are all MANDATORY if you are in the following courses (Geometry, high school Biology, US History, AMH1010/AMH1020, and high school US Government). 
