STEPS TO REGISTRATION

Steps to Admission can be found on the website at http://www.polk.edu/admission-aid/dual-enrollment-early-admission/.

- All students must register with a college advisor. Public high schools will host an admission event and a registration event prior to the beginning of each term. Students may attend any event on any campus or come to the College to see an advisor. <u>Polk County School</u> <u>Board students</u> should attend an admission event on their high school campuses.
- Start by downloading or obtaining this Dual Enrollment Approval form and taking it to your high school counselor for approval. This signed and completed form must be brought with you when you see a college advisor. Polk County School Board Students should start the process through DELTA the School Board's dual enrollment portal rather than a form.
- o *In all e-mail from Florida Virtual High School students to Polk State College, the subject line should state: [FLVS: Your Name].

RULES TO PARTICIPATE

- 1. Students are required to take the College's student orientation and present a copy of the student orientation certificate at the time of registration.
- 2. Students may participate in any combination of dual enrollment, early admission, and the accelerated degree program for a total of three academic years.
- 3. Students must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 at Polk State and continue to maintain a high school GPA of 3.00 in order to remain eligible for the dual enrollment program.
- 4. Early Admission students, including accelerated degree program students, must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 at Polk State and maintain a high school GPA of at least 3.20 to remain eligible for the early admission program or the accelerated degree program.
- 5. The College covers two attempts at a course. Third and subsequent attempts must be paid for by the student after completion of high school and at the "full cost of instruction," which is generally equivalent to out of state tuition.
- 6. The College does not provide transportation to any college campus or center for dual enrollment. Transportation will be the responsibility of the student.
- All students, including dual enrollment students, are subject to FERPA privacy laws. Parents are not permitted information about the student's attendance, academic performance, or grades without proper FERPA permission regardless of the site where the class is held. Read the College Catalog for additional FERPA information. Advisors do not have nor are they able to provide attendance and grade information to parents.
- 8. Students may withdraw from a dual enrollment course and receive a grade of "*W*" on their college transcript; however, the high school grade assigned for a withdrawal is based on the rules and regulations of the high school. Only the student, professor, or college administration can withdraw a student from a college class.

STUDENT AND PARENT AGREEMENT

- 1. I agree to abide by both Polk State College and high school rules and policies. I am aware that inappropriate conduct will result in administrative withdrawal from Polk State College coursework and possible other consequences.
- 2. I am aware that enrolling in a Polk State College course is voluntary, that I will be in class with regular college students of varying ages, and that Polk State College is not required to conduct background screening of its instructors and employees to the extent that is required by the PCSB.
- 3. I understand that Polk State College courses, textbooks, materials, and lectures are developed for the adult student, age 18 or older, and will not be modified or changed to accommodate younger students.
- 4. I understand that I am obligated to the attendance policy on the class's syllabus.
- 5. I understand that academic expectations are at the postsecondary level and that grades become a permanent part of <u>both</u> my college <u>and</u> high school records. I authorize Polk State College to forward my placement test results, my class schedule, and my grades to my high school for inclusion on my high school transcripts.
- I am aware that parents may <u>NOT</u> access a student's college records, including attendance, grades, and any other non-directory information, <u>unless</u> the student follows procedures to allow parental permission. (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act – FERPA).
- 7. I understand that even with FERPA rights, Polk State College faculty are not under obligation to share information with parents regardless of where the classes are held.
- 8. I understand that I may be registered for recommended alternatives to approved courses that are not available within my program objective.
- 9. I understand that class registration activity is between the student and Polk State College, not the student and the high school.
