The District Board of Trustees has adopted a policy on Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) and Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS). The purpose of this rule is to establish the College policy and guidelines affecting those diagnosed as infected with HIV and/or AIDS, and to direct the establishment of a program by the President for students and employees of the College that meets statutory requirements.

1. To promote knowledge and understanding, the College will establish a policy describing how it will utilize general education classes and extracurricular activities to provide HIV/AIDS instruction, information, and activities that emphasize the known modes of transmission, signs and symptoms, associated risk factors, and the means used to control the spread of HIV/AIDS.
2. Through the Student Catalog/Handbook, the College will provide information related to HIV/AIDS education and identify sites from which HIV/AIDS education information may be obtained.
