\_\_\_ 6. Apply through **Etrieve** (May 15-31 for August admission or August 15-31 for January admission).

\_\_\_ 7. Cost of program approximately \$14,000

\_\_\_ 8. Prepared for time commitment:

- Class two days/week 8a-4p
- Clinical lab two hours/week
- Clinicals one day/week 6a-3 or 2-11p (need reliable transportation)
- Study time (at least 10 hours/week)
