The College is authorized to operate or to contract for food services, vending machines bookstores, and other self-supporting activities as a service to, and incidental to, the instructional program of the College. These activities will be operated on a self-sustaining basis.

Auxiliary enterprise funds and undesignated gifts may be spent for the benefit of the College for:

- A. Promotion and public relations, including but not limited to: graduation, visiting committees, orientation and work conferences, personnel recruitment, meetings, receptions, and guest speakers.
- B. Hospitality of business guests at the College and elsewhere. Such hospitality expenditures shall not exceed the amount authorized for such purpose by State Board of Education Rules.

Funds expended under the provision of this policy may be disbursed at the discretion of the President. All funds used for such purposes shall be transferred to the General Current Fund (Fund One) and included in the approved operating budget of the College.
