Boards of Trustees for Florida State Colleges are authorized to adopt rules, procedures, and policies related to tangible personal property, and they are charged with the responsibility for control of College-owned property. These Boards are also required to approve disposal of tangible personal property.

Polk State College's District Board of Trustees authorizes the President to issue such procedures and policies as are necessary to ensure compliance with the guidelines for managing tangible personal property that have been adopted by the Florida College System Council of Business Affairs and the Council of Presidents.

This Rule supersedes *District Board of Trustees (DBOT) Rule 5.15: Disposal of Tangible Personal Property* and *DBOT Rule 5.19: Tangible Personal Property*.
