## A Few Notes:

- In addition to the courses above, we also recommend completing the four (4) courses below if you are transferring to UCF's Digital Media program: DIG 2000C Introduction to Digital Media, DIG 2030C Digital Video and Sound, DIG 2109C Digital Imaging Fundamentals, DIG 2500C Fundamentals of Interactive Design
- 2. Students are required to complete two 3-credit Mathematics courses; one course must be from List A; the other can be from List A or B. <u>Refer to the College Catalog</u> for Mathematics Lists A and B.
- 3. Pursuant to Rule 6A-10.02413 of the Florida Administrative Code, all degree-seeking students must demonstrate competency in civic literacy by both passing the Florida Civic Literacy Exam and by

completion of AMH 1010 (History of the United States: 1607-1877), AMH 1020 (History of the United States: 1877 to the Present) or POS 2041 (American National Government). Students may also use AP or CLEP credit for one of the three-course options.

- 4. Students intending to transfer to UCF should enroll in ART2330C Figure Drawing I.
- 5. Students must meet all graduation requirements. To learn more about graduation requirements, please refer to the College Catalog.
- 6. The AA degree requires the completion of 60 credit hours, including 36 credit hours of General Education courses and 24 credit hours of elective courses. This transfer intent requires the completion of additional courses to meet all pre-requisites for admission into a bachelor's degree program at a state university. These additional courses are in excess of required program hours and may not be covered by financial aid. Students should speak to their Student Success Advisor for more information.
