3. Pursuant to Rule 6A-10.02413 of the Florida Administrative Code, all degree-seeking students must demonstrate competency in civic literacy by both passing the Florida Civic Literacy Exam and by



completion of AMH 1010 (History of the United States: 1607-1877), AMH 1020 (History of the United States: 1877 to the Present) or POS 2041 (American National Government). Students may also use AP or CLEP credit for one of the three-course options.

4. Students intending to transfer to UCF should enroll in ART2330C Figure Drawing I.

6. The AA degree requires the completion of 60 credit hours, including 36 credit hours of General Education courses and 24 credit hours of elective courses. This transfer intent requires the completion of additional courses to meet all pre-requisites for admission into a bachelor's degree program at a state university.
