Note 1: Program prerequisites:

- Admission to this program requires an AS or AA degree (or the equivalent) from a regionally-accredited school or college.
- A minimum of 2.0 grade point average on a 4.0 point scale.
- Students with an AAS may need to complete additional general education courses before admission to the program can be granted.

Note 2: Foreign language requirement must be met before graduation. Demonstrate proficiency in a foreign language through any of the following means: completion of two years of high school instruction in the same foreign language, completion of a minimum of 8 college-level credits in one foreign language, achievement of minimum scores on a foreign language proficiency exam approved by the Registrar's Office, or completion of a high school diploma from a foreign country where the student studied in a language other than English.
