

Tuition Waiver for Public School Teachers for the ESE one credit or three Credit course at Polk State College

Pursuant to Section 1009.26(10), Florida Statutes, Florida colleges may waive tuition and associated matriculation fees for full-time classroom teachers enrolled in this course, EEX2082 or EEX2083, Teaching Students with Learning Disabilities, 1 credit, and Motivating Students with Learning Disabilities, 3 credits approved by the Department of Education. Section 1012.01(2)(a), Florida Statutes, defines a classroom teacher as one who must be employed on a full-time basis by a school district and must meet the academic requirements established by the state university or college.

Please read the directions carefully:

- 1. If you have never attended Polk State College, complete an application for admission to Polk State College. Go to www.polk.edu and click on "Admission & Aid" on the black toolbar. On the next screen, click on "Apply Online" located on the right side of your screen. Finally, on this screen you will choose the first option "admission for never attended before." This will allow you to complete the full application. When you complete the application, indicate you are taking a credit class but are not seeking a degree (non-degree seeking). This should take all of 15 minutes max.
- 2. If you have attended Polk State College in the past, go to www.polk.edu and click on "Admission & Aid" on the black toolbar. On the next screen, click on "Apply Online" located on the right side of your screen. Finally, on this screen you will choose the third option "Readmission or Information update" This will allow you to edit address, phone, etc...if you need to. Should take all of 10 minutes max. Note: If you have attended within the last year, then you can skip this step.
- 3. You will receive your student ID and pin number when you hit the submit button on your application form. Be sure and write it down.
- 4. You do not need to send transcripts or take the online orientation.
- Complete and submit the waiver form below to Joshua Plazak, Assistant Registrar, at jplazak@polk.edu
- 6. Provide a letter on letterhead stationery from the HR department at the Polk School District or your school principal stating that you are a full-time classroom teacher and indicate the years of employment and submit with the waiver form.
- 7. Lorraine Sleyzak is the contact in Polk County School Board Human Resource Services for those who need the letter to verify employment.

Directions for logging into PAL

- Go to the Polk State College website homepage www.polk.edu
- Select "PAL" from the menu bar at the top of the page.
- Log-into PAL

- Username: Polk State College e-mail address username
 If your Polk State College e-mail address is jdoe@my.polk.edu, then your
 PAL username is jdoe.
- Password: Passport pin which is the two digits of your month of birth and the last two digits of the year.
- Ex. If you were born March 1985 then your password would be: 0385
