How Do I Sign Up for the ACT?

Online registration is the fastest method. You will know immediately if your preferred test center has space for you to test, and you also can print your admission ticket from the website. How you sign up depends on where and how you plan to test: please see below for how to register.

If you plan to test at a <u>national or international test center</u>, sign up online by creating or logging in to your <u>ACT</u>
<u>Web account</u>

•If you are requesting <u>extended time</u> or <u>other accommodations</u> for the first time, sign up online by creating or logging in to your <u>ACT Web account</u> or <u>register by mail</u> **in addition to** completing the application request and submitting required documentation.

•If you missed the late registration deadline, you can request standby testing online.

12.If you know which schools you'd like to receive your scores, then consider sending them in the spring of your junior year. Colleges see this as a sign of interest and may use scores to qualify you for special campus visits programs, information sessions in your hometown or for scholarships.
