#### A Few Notes:

- 1. Students must meet all graduation requirements, including demonstrating proficiency in a foreign language. To learn more about graduation requirements, <u>please refer to the College Catalog</u>.
- Pursuant to Rule 6A-10.02413 of the Florida Administrative Code, all degree-seeking students
  must demonstrate competency in civic literacy by both passing the Florida Civic Literacy Exam and
  by completion of either AMH 1020 (History of the United States: 1877 to the Present) or POS 2041
  (American National Government). Students may also use AP or CLEP credit for one of the two
  courses options.
- 3. The AA degree requires the completion of 60 credit hours, including 36 credit hours of General Education courses and 24 credit hours of elective courses. This transfer intent requires the completion of additional courses to meet all pre-requisites for admission into a bachelor's degree program at a state university. These additional courses are in excess of required program hours and may not be covered by financial aid. Students should speak to their Student Success Advisor for more information.



4. Students are required to complete two 3-credit Mathematics courses. One course must be from List A; the other can be from List A or B. Refer to the College Catalog for Mathematics Lists A and B.
