IPS FEES

(Must be a Florida resident for at least 1 year in order to qualify for Florida resident fees)

Failure to pay fees by the first scheduled day of class will result in cancellation of the student's registration and the student will NOT be admitted to class.

Please contact PSC Financial Aid immediately after you are notified you are accepted into the academy if you are depending solely on VA or Financial Aid monies to pay your academy fees!

CRIMINAL HISTORY

All applicants are required to go through the fingerprinting process for the academy per 943.14 (7) FSS. Processing of fingerprints is a mandatory and **NON-REFUNDABLE \$56.25**.

APPLICANT SCREENING FEE: \$100.00 – Due when the Law Enforcement application is submitted & is mandatory & **NON-REFUNDABLE**.

TESTING

All applicants must take the **Basic Abilities Test (BAT)**, as mandated by 943.17(1)(g) FSS. The registration fee is \$45 and **NON-REFUNDABLE**.

NOTE: Law Enforcement Basic Recruit Training Program applicants who are either a veteran or hold an Associate degree or higher from an accredited college or university, are exempt from the Law Enforcement Basic Abilities Test requirement.

Polygraph Examination: The applicant will be responsible for scheduling their polygraph exam, with an IPS approved polygraphist upon completion of a pre-screening application. **\$175 NON-REFUNDABLE**.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

A complete physical examination, including an EKG, is required of each applicant and must be done by an approved licensed physician. A 7-panel drug screen is also required. The forms supplied by IPS **must be utilized**. The results of the examinations and the drug screen must be submitted to the IPS along with the application. **\$180**
