SADDI KHALI BIOGRAPHY:

He has worked for the last 20 years to blend the most effective mix of art and activism. As a critically acclaimed poet, his writings have been published in numerous national journals and anthologies, including Dark Eros, Beyond the Frontier, and Be a Father to Your Child. As a performer, Saddi has been featured on HBO's Def Poetry Jam and he has headlined at the Apollo Theater's Salon Series (with Toni Blackman). For two years, he also toured nationally with the traveling theater experience, UPROOTED: The Katrina Project.

Recognized by his peers as one of the foremost authorities on the art of therapeutic photography as well as reclaiming and embracing the natural image, Khali uses photography to capture the vulnerability, beauty, grace and strength that so often pass us by in a blur of traffic, deadlines, family commitments and perceived physical flaws.
