

- Polk State Reopening Phases 1, 2 & 3
- All students, staff & visitors must wear facemasks while on campus
- Hand sanitizer available throughout the campus
- Social distancing
- Contact tracing
- Visitors logs





Campus Safety Discussion

- Polk County Sherriff's officers on duty full time during student hours (7:00 AM 11:00 PM)
- Polk State campus security officers on duty 24/7
- Emergency call boxes located across campus
- Emergency notification system for CHS and Polk State
- Enhanced high school safety procedures
 - Safety glass on all exposed windows of CHS offices and classrooms
 - Intercom system
 - Lockdown capabilities
 - Security cameras
 - Active assailant drills
 - Fire drills
- Zero tolerance for alcohol, drugs, bullying and violent acts





School Year Information

- CHS courses will operate in E-School mode for the Fall of 2020
 - Mode A Fully virtual (livestream class meetings/online learning via Canvas)
 - Mode B Hybrid (in-person learning with small classes, livestream & online via Canvas)
 - CHS courses will use combination of livestream instruction and online learning as the school year begins (no in-person class meetings in the beginning)
 - Livestream class meetings are in <u>real time</u> and attendance is expected just as in-person attendance is required
 - Students should <u>not</u> schedule work hours during the school day!
 - CHS courses will transition to small group, in-person learning combined with livestream and online learning if health situation significantly improves
 - Students who have health conditions can choose livestream/online learning only
 - CHS high school courses begin August 3rd
 - CHS leadership course begins August 5th
 - CHS college courses begin August 17th

Polk State

- Polk State College courses will operate in online mode for Fall term 2020
 - Most Polk State classes will be 100% online through Canvas
 - Some Polk State classes may have a livestream component combined with online learning
 - Some Polk State Courses (Science lab courses, etc.) may have a limited in-person component combined with online learning
 - Polk State college courses begin August 17th

- Leadership course teacher serves as your mentor at CHS






Student Packet

- All forms must be completed, signed and returned
 - Medical forms are <u>required</u> by district and state policy missing medical forms could result in denial of access to courses
 - FERPA form permission for CHS faculty and staff to discuss academic progress
 - Lunch Form fill out if you usually do this lunch service resumes once on campus instruction returns ACT/SAT waiver eligibility
 - Field Trip Permission Form covers trips for the school year
 - Change of Address Form if your address has changed since application
 - Opt-out Directory Information Form students who don't want names/photos published
 - CHS staff notaries are available if needed
- Campus pick-up times for new students who did not attend in person orientation sessions are Thursday 8/6 & Friday 8/7 12:00-3:00 (notary available)
- Form return times for students who attended virtual orientation are Monday 8/10 & Tuesday 8/11






Textbooks
