  - Additional officers being added this year
- Polk State campus security officers on duty 24/7
- Emergency call boxes located across campus
- Emergency notification system for CHS and Polk State
- Enhanced high school safety procedures
  - Safety glass on all exposed windows of CHS offices and classrooms
  - Intercom system
  - Lockdown capabilities
  - Security cameras
  - Active assailant drills Monthly
  - Fire drills Monthly
- Zero tolerance for alcohol, drugs, bullying and violent acts



  - Change of Address Form if your address has changed since application
  - Opt-out Directory Information Form students who don't want names/photos published

- Form should be returned by Friday, August 13<sup>th</sup>






## Textbooks
