Information and Resources to Help You Prepare

The purpose of the Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (P.E.R.T.) is to determine accurate course placement based on the student's skills and abilities.

P. E.R.T. is administered to determine readiness for Intermediate Algebra (MAT 1033), and Freshman Composition I (ENC 1101). The scaled scores on the P.E.R.T. Placement range from 50-150.

The P.E.R.T. is not timed

So you will be able to work through the test at your own pace.

P.E.R.T. Has 3 Sections

1 WRITING 30 questions Tests sentence skills <i>103 is the cut score</i>	2 READING 30 questions Tests reading comprehension <i>106 is the cut score</i>	3 MATH 30 questions Tests general math & Algebra <i>114 is the cut score</i>
