What do you think the biggest trends are today? What are your everyday favorites to wear? Where do you find these trends? Who inspires you?

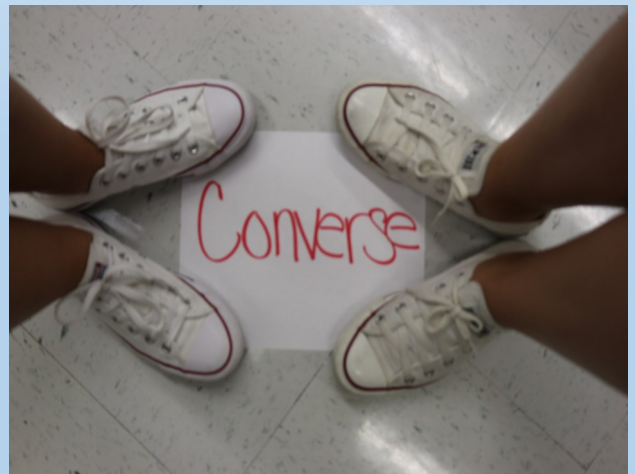
