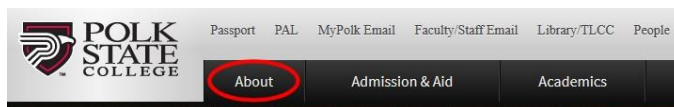


# Connecting to Polk State Secure Wireless-Student

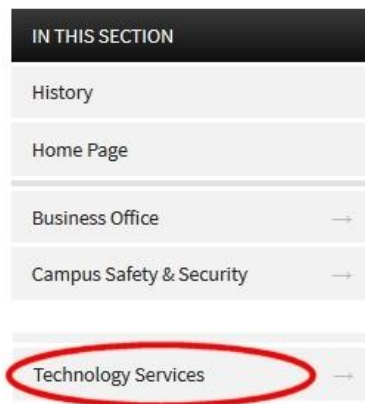
1. Click the wireless icon in the system tray and then click "EAGLE-CONNECT", then click "Connect"



2. Once connected, open your web browser (preferably Chrome or Firefox) and navigate to [www.polk.edu](http://www.polk.edu)
3. Click the "About" button.



4. Click the "Technology Services" link on the left sidebar (at the very bottom.)



5. Click the “Technology Infrastructure and User Support Services” link on the left sidebar.



6. Click the “Wireless Access” link on the left sidebar.



7. Click the “Create Your Personal Wireless Key” link.

## Get Connected to Polk State College Wireless

This site will guide you how to best enroll and access the wireless network at Polk State College.

**NOTE: The links below to create a personal key are only accessible on-campus for security reasons.**

### Students

1. **Create Your Personal Wireless Key** that can be used on up to three devices. Be sure and login with your @my.polk.edu Office 365 username and password.

**NOTE: This key should not be shared with anyone as it is assigned to your account**


2. A personal key will be generated and displayed on screen as well as emailed to your @my.polk.edu email account.
3. Select the POLKSTATE-SECURE wireless network and when prompted enter the key that was provided

8. You will be directed to a Wireless Key Request screen. Click “Log In”





9. When prompted, enter your Polk State Email address that ends in “@my.polk.edu” and click the “Sign In” button.



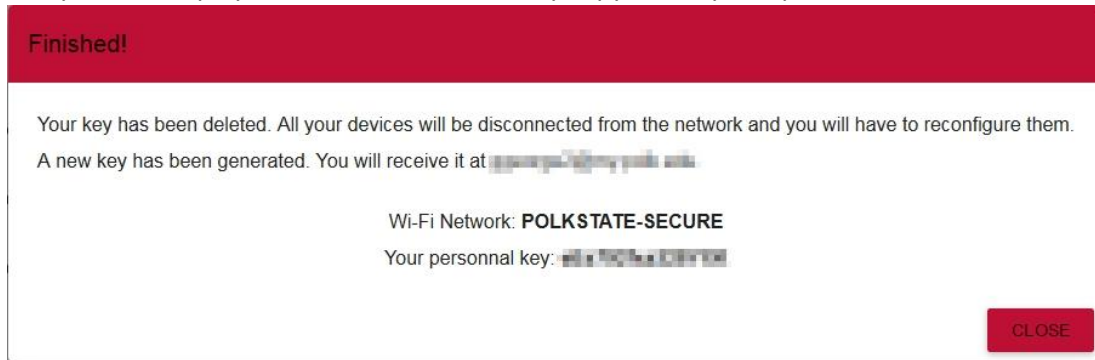
