MEET THE COACHING STAFF...

HEAD COACH AL CORBEIL

Head Baseball Coach Al Corbeil enters his third year at Polk State.

Under Corbeil's watch, the Eagles in 2012 earned a berth to the NJCAA JUCO World Series, the first in the program's history. The College's appearance on the national stage came after Corbeil led his team to its second consecutive Suncoast Conference Championship win, and a victory in the title game of the FCSAA/NJCAA Division 1 Gulf District Baseball Tournament.

In 2012, seven Eagles earned FCSAA/NJCAA Gulf District All-Tournament honors; three earned FCSAA All-State First Team nods; two received FSCAA Second Team selections; and 11 were named Suncoast All Conference. The team ended the 2012 season ranked No. 3 in the nation.

In his first two seasons at Polk, Corbeil's record is 89-24-1.

Corbeil resides in Lakeland with his wife, Whitney, and son, Azarias.

ASSISTANT COACH COLLIN MARTIN

Collin Martin enters his third season as an assistant baseball coach at Polk State.

In his first two years, the program's offense earned 15 All-Conference selections, including five All-State selections and 2012's Suncoast Conference Player of the Year for Conor Szczerba. The Eagles led the Suncoast Conference in two consecutive seasons in runs scored, 395; RBI, 351; batting average, .293; doubles, 94; triples, 17; homeruns, 24; total extra base hits, 135; hit-by-pitches, 91; stolen bases, 161; walks, 227. Since Martin's arrival, the program has also been a state leader in runs scored, RBI, and stolen bases.

Since 2011, the Eagles have broken numerous school offensive records, including runs, RBI, doubles, triples, at-bats, walks, stolen bases and hit-by-pitches.

He is the son of Philadelphia Phillies Manager Charlie Manuel and currently resides in Winter Haven.

ASSISTANT COACH BRAD COOK


Assistant Baseball Coach Brad Cook is entering his third year as pitching coach at Polk State.

In 2012, the College's pitchers led the NJCAA and the state in several categories and set numerous school records. The staff's 1.99 ERA and 2.89 runs-allowed average were best in the country. Polk pitchers also led the state in innings pitched, 496.1 (No. 2 nationally); opponent batting average, .214 (No. 2 nationally); and walks allowed per game, 2.4 (No. 3 nationally). In all of those categories, Polk pitchers set new school records.

Under Cook, Alec Asher in 2012 was selected as the Suncoast Conference Pitcher of the Year, Florida State Pitcher of the Year, NJCAA First Team All-American and a Rawlings Gold Glove recipient. He was selected by the Texas Rangers in the fourth round of the 2012 MLB draft.

Cook resides in Winter Haven with wife, Sarah, and son, Broderick.

From Tampa: Take I-275 North to I-4 East via Exit 45B toward Orlando. Take Exit 28 toward US-92. Merge onto W. Memorial Blvd. W. Memorial Blvd. becomes US-92 E. Turn slight right onto Havendale Blvd. Turn right onto 1st St/SR-549 S. Turn left onto Avenue K NE. Turn right onto Lake Martha Dr. Turn left onto Avenue H NE.

From South Florida: Take the Florida Turnpike N. to exit 193, SR-60 W. toward Lake Wales. Merge onto US-27 N., toward Haines City. Turn left onto Dundee Rd/SR-542. Turn slight right onto E. Lake Elbert Dr., NE. Turn right on 10th St., NE, then take first left onto Avenue H NE.

From North Florida: Take I-75 S. Merge onto Florida's Turnpike via Exit 328 toward Orlando. Take Exit 289 US-27 S. Turn right onto Dundee Rd/SR-542. Turn slight right onto E. Lake Elbert Dr., NE. Turn Right on 10th St NE, then take first left onto Avenue H NE.
